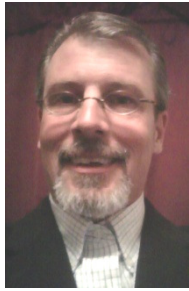

What's been happening in the World of Mercedes-Benz this month?



ADVANCE LOOK at the 2013 SL

Information is showing up on the Internet about the all new 2013 SL. The image to the left is purported to be of the new version of the SL. Design cues reminiscent of the [SLS AMG](#) are unmistakable, and the new SL also takes on a fairly prominent iteration of the corporate front fascia. Underneath, Mercedes is promising a new aluminum architecture that will save weight while boosting rigidity.



SMART News

Smart has revealed a series of sketches depicting a compact pickup concept that will make its public debut at January auto shows. Named the Forus, a name chosen to indicate its suitability for the pickup-loving U.S. market, the electric-powered two-seater was conceived as part of plans to extend the scope of the [Smart](#) lineup. At 139.7 inches in length, 59.3 inches in width and 66.0 inches in height, the Forus is substantially longer and higher than the existing Fortwo.



SLK55 AMG

The SLK55 is the latest Mercedes-Benz to get the AMG treatment. With a 415 hp and 398 lb-ft of torque from its normally aspirated and direct-injection 5.5-liter V8. There's stop/start and cylinder deactivation, which cuts the two, three, five and eight cylinders during cruising. Expect fuel mileage to in the 25 MPG area.

THE HAPPY CAR COLUMN

This Month: More Cold Weather Tips

It seems that there is no shortage of opinions about cars and cold weather. We have touched on the subjects of driving in the snow but how does the cold weather affect our cars?

The long standing debate about warming our cars up before driving away in them has been a hot topic now that it is against the law in most jurisdictions within the Metro area. This month we will look into some of the technical aspects and how it is actually better for your car to not warm up first. Several aspects are considered to come up with this theory and we will lightly touch upon these.

Oil viscosity refers to the “thickness” or consistency of the liquid. Modern engine oils are created with a multi-viscosity giving us the nomenclature such as 10w 30. A 10w 30 motor oil has a viscosity of 10, or it is rather thin, when at room temperature. This thin oil allows for quick distribution throughout the engine and for easier starting. As the engine and oil temperatures increase, the viscosity of the oil thickens (the 30 in the grade) allowing for greater protection at increased speed and load. When temperatures are extremely cold, the oil becomes the consistency of molasses which is why it may require you to crank the engine longer before it starts.

The oils in every other system on board your vehicle such as the transmission, differential(s), shock absorbers, etc... are of a single viscosity and will not even begin the warm up process until the vehicle is set in motion. It is possible to do severe damage to these components by unleashing the power of a fully warmed engine on them. I have actually seen a shock absorber shear the mounting bolt when the driver hit a pothole immediately after starting out.

By allowing the vehicle to warm up as a unit, while driving gently, all of the components warm up faster and the chances of expensive damage is reduced. Not to mention that you don't have to worry about someone driving off in your car while you get a cup of coffee.
